## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This show will be run under both the rules of AQHA-NZ and AQHA. All classes judged by AQHA judge will be judged per the current AQHA Rulebook. Classes with less than three (3) entries may be combined with like classes to create a point earning class eg, Junior and Senior Youth may be combined where there are less than three (3) entries in one or both of the youth classes. This applies to Amateur and Select Amateur OR Junior and Senior Horse.

### **❖ AQHA-NZ CLASSES**

- All horses entered in AQHA-NZ Classes must be registered with AQHA-NZ
- All horse owners and riders and/or handlers must be current financial members of AQHA-NZ
- All horses will pay a \$25 administration fee

### **❖ AQHA CLASSES**

- All horses entered in AQHA classes must be registered with AQHA, and must on request provide copy of registration
- All horse owners must be current members of AQHA
- All riders/handlers must be current members of AQHA
- All horses entered in AQHA classes must pay an additional \$20 processing fee
-

### **❖ PRIZE MONEY, RIBBONS AND TROPHIES**

Unless the class is otherwise sponsored:

- If there is only one entry in the class no prize money will be paid
- If there are 2 or 3 entries in the Class then only 1st Place prizemoney will be paid
- If there are 4 or 5 entries in the Class then only 1st and 2nd place prizemoney will be paid
- If there are 6 or more entries in the class then 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizemoney will be paid

#### ❖ ADMINISTRATION FEES AND LATE FEES

- An administration fee of \$25 will apply for each horse shown
- There will be an additional \$20 AQHA processing fee payable for any horse shown in AQHA class
- A late fee is payable for all entries received after 26th February - the fee is \$50 per horse

#### ❖ EXTRA FEES

- Stables, Covered and uncovered yards are all \$20 per horse per night
- Unpowered camping \$10 per night per vehicle
- Powered camping \$20 per night per vehicle
- Facility fee (per night of stay) \$12 per horse per night/day  
*(note; if your horse is not staying on the grounds overnight, you MUST pay the facility fee for each day your horse is on site.*

#### ❖ NATIONAL SHOW TRIFECTA

The horse that wins the Yearling Halter futurity, Two Year Old Halter Maturity and Western Pleasure or Ranch Riding Futurity in each consecutive year will be awarded \$500 prizemoney as winner of the AQHA-NZ National Show Trifecta

#### ❖ SHOW RULES AND PATTERNS

- This show is run under the rules of AQHA-NZ and the AQHA (2024 rule book)
- All patterns are as per the 2024 AQHA Rulebook

#### ❖ HORSE NUMBERS

Competitors to use NZWRF Permanent Horse Numbers only and these must be clearly stated on entry forms

#### ❖ SATURDAY NIGHT DINNER AND NATIONAL SHOW AWARDS

- Dinner and Awards evening will be held on the grounds. Starting approximately 7.00 pm on Saturday Night
- Dinner cost is \$30.00 per person. Children 12 and under is \$15 per person
- Please make sure you book your meal on the Facilities and Dinner Form

#### ❖ REFUNDS

Refunds (less admin fees) will only be paid, when a Veterinarian's Certificate or Doctor's Certificate is produced within seven (7) days of the show, but must be dated prior to or during the show.

#### ❖ HAY

Hay will be available to be purchased for \$15 bale. You can book this on your entry form and pay with your entry fees.

#### ❖ TYING UP OF HORSES

- Horses must be tied up in a safe manner
- Horses must not be tied up to horse trailers that are not connected to a tow vehicle

#### ❖ **GROUND RULES**

- Stallions are not to use yards/outside pens, they must always be in a stable or tied to your float/truck under supervision
- The grounds, stables, yards, and wash down bays are to be left clean and tidy
- All manure must be removed from yards, stables, and all outdoor areas. There will be no manure bins by the pens. Please ensure all manure is to be disposed of in the manure pile (concrete pad)
- All hay and rubbish to be picked up and disposed of in the skip bin provided
- To help keep any mess to a minimum please ensure all hay nets are tied to the back of the yards or stables - do not feed loose hay
- Please do not wash manure into the drains of the wash down bays. Please remove and place in the bins provided.

#### ❖ **DOGS**

- All dogs are to be kept on a leash at all times
- No Dogs are to be in the show arena building including the spectator area
- No Dogs are to be in the warm up arena
- There is a dog park very close by which is a great place to exercise dogs

#### ❖ **DRUG TESTING**

- Drug testing will take place
- All horses entered into this show must be able to be presented for a drug test when it is required
- If horses have finished competing and are to be administered drugs, then prior to drugs being administered, a form must be completed with the office and approved
- Horse owners should check prior to removing horses from the grounds if their horses are required for testing

#### ❖ **TRAINING EQUIPMENT**

For the duration of this show on these showgrounds no training equipment is permitted other than what is permitted to show your horse in the class, however leg bandages and leg wraps are permitted as are synthetic training headpieces (nylon bridles).

#### ❖ **HELMETS**

Approved yellow or red tagged helmets are to be used at all times UNLESS you are competing in a class, or warming up for your class.

#### ❖ **SAFETY AND WELFARE**

- The safety and welfare of the people and animals is paramount
- All members, riders, horse owners and supporters are expected to act in a safe and considerate manner at all times
- Please be aware of the risks and hazards that exist on all showgrounds and act accordingly to avoid harm to yourself and others
- There will be welfare officers observing at the grounds at all times

#### ❖ **BIOSECURITY**

- It is in horse owners' best interest to ensure your horse has been inoculated from disease like strangles etc on an annual basis
- Horse owners please be considerate and do not bring onto the grounds horses with viral infections that may easily spread to others
- Care should be taken to not share feed and water buckets with other horses to reduce the risk of spreading diseases
- Please refrain from allowing your dogs to wander through horse yards as this may also spread disease from one area to the other
